- Endowed Scholarships** (Purple, vertical ellipse): Long duration (Decades), narrow scope (Students).
- Alumni Relations** (Pink, large horizontal ellipse): Long duration (Decades), broad scope (Faculty to Community).
- Sponsorship of Professional Meetings** (Blue, horizontal ellipse): Medium duration (Years), broad scope (Faculty to Community).
- Internships** (Cyan, horizontal ellipse): Short duration (Months), narrow scope (Students).
- Annual Newsletter** (Green, horizontal ellipse): Medium duration (Years), narrow scope (Faculty).
- Web Site** (Cyan, horizontal ellipse): Medium duration (Years), broad scope (Faculty to Community).
- Student Awards** (Purple, horizontal ellipse): Short duration (Months), narrow scope (Students).
- Advising** (Yellow, horizontal ellipse): Short duration (Months), narrow scope (Students).
- Seminar** (Pink, horizontal ellipse): Short duration (Months), narrow scope (Faculty).
- Social Activities** (Pink, horizontal ellipse): Short duration (Months), narrow scope (Faculty).
- News Releases** (Orange, horizontal ellipse): Short duration (Months), broad scope (Faculty to Community).
