The ArcVoyager Menu

ArcVoyager has four basic sections. As you move from section to section, you will work with more geographic concepts, more data, more geographic information system (GIS) functions, and more decision making.

Section Name	What does it do?	What else should I know?
Exploring Key Concepts: Teach Me 	This section is your introduction to basic concepts about GIS, mapping, computers and data.	This section will assist you in using ArcVoyager and will demonstrate some of ArcVoyager's capabilities.
Viewing World Snapshots: Show Me 	This section is a world atlas. It displays maps on nearly twenty different topics.	This section will help you start using ArcVoyager's mapping tools. Emphasized skills are: • Navigate around a map • Add themes to a view • Turn themes on and off • Print maps to paper or graphic files
Designing Global Adventures: Teach Me 	This section is the starting point for guided exploration. It provides you with prepared projects that span the globe and projects that focus on specific areas such as Southeast Asia and the United States.	This section provides you with several projects for exploring different parts of the world and selected areas. You will use more GIS tools and skills, building upon your experience with the World Atlas in the previous section.
Creating New Worlds: Turn Me Loose 	This section puts you in the driver's seat. It provides an opportunity for you to create your own projects focused on any area or topic.	This section allows you to create new projects using all of the data, tools and skills you have worked with in the previous sections.
