Fellowship Opportunities

The Gulf Research Program offers two fellowships that provide early-career researchers and professionals in the social and behavioral sciences, health and medicine, engineering and physical sciences, earth and life sciences, and relevant interdisciplinary fields the unique opportunity to hone their skills while working at the intersections of human health, environmental resources, and offshore energy safety.

Early-Career Research Fellowship

Take a risk on research not yet tested, pursue unique collaborations, and build a network of interdisciplinary colleagues.

Our Early-Career Research Fellows:

- Receive two years of funding to pursue their own innovative, untested research
- Connect with a network of researchers across disciplines, including current & past fellows and experts at the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine
- Build their skills and confidence with the encouragement and support of a mentor of their choosing

Fellowships will be awarded to early-career scientists who have received their final degree within the past 10 years.

Science Policy Fellowship

Hone your skills by putting them to practice for the benefit of Gulf region communities and ecosystems.

Our Science Policy Fellows:

- Gain a year of hands-on experience alongside practitioners and decision makers in the Gulf of Mexico region
- Connect with a network of colleagues at their host office, current & past fellows, and experts at the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine
- Build their professional skills with training opportunities and the guidance of a mentor

Fellowships will be awarded to graduate or professional students who will have completed their degree by August 2020.
